

Indications for Referral to Secondary Care

✓ Referral for Extra Tests

- o Diagnosis Unclear
- o Poor Response to treatment particularly
- o Inhaled steroid use of more than > 400 micron. /day
- o Frequent use of steroid tablets
- o Severe or Life-threatening Asthma Attack

✓ Red Flag Indicators

- o Severe upper respiratory tract infections
- o Failure to thrive
- o Symptoms present since birth
- o Excessive vomiting or posseting
- o Persistent wet or productive cough
- o Family history of unusual chest disease
- o Nasal polyps
- o Unexplained clinical findings
 - Focal signs
 - Abnormal voice or cry
 - Dysphagia
 - Inspiratory stridor

✓ Patient or Parental Anxiety
